Desert Sage Auxiliary

The Auxiliary's **Help for HOPE Scholars** program gave financial support to **14** students in the UNLV HOPE Scholars Program. Its **Angel's Assistance** program provided memory boxes to parents who lost a child at birth; bereavement bags to ER patients who suffered a pregnancy loss; activity bags for pediatric hospital patients; and health kits and blankets to new mothers in need.
 In total, **1,116** items were donated to local area hospitals.

Volunteers Auxiliary

Our teenage group championed programs starting with **Perfect Fit** which gave **221** youthful plus-size clothing to teenage students.
 Over **1,500** food and hygiene supply kits were assembled for homeless youth. They provided two nonprofits with **2,340** feminine hygiene supplies.
 Other nonprofits received **1,520** pairs of socks and underwear and **440** blankets were donated to these agencies as well.
